TO TURN YOUR BATTERIES IN

TAPE THE TERMINALS.

Cover the ends of your batteries with clear tape, especially the contact points. This helps prevent sparks and keeps everyone safe.

MAKE A PLAN.

Different batteries may need different return options. Scan the QR code or visit BatterySafetyNow.org, enter your zip code and battery type, and we'll show you drop-off locations. Batteries in this area should be returned to:
